ATTENDANCE

Some of you may have noticed Philippa at the front of the school from around 9am until 9.30am talking to students and whanau who have arrived at school a little late. We want to improve student attendance with a particular focus on those students who regularly arrive late.

Our aim is to help whanau and students do their best to arrive on time to be engaged with learning and be less disruptive for teachers and other students. If we can talk with families about attendance then we can work on ways to improve.

Although lateness is improving, we still had 12 students late today. We really do appreciate families who make an effort to get their children to school on time.

Children need to be at school by 8.55 am every day

If your child is going to be absent or you know he/she is having difficulty with lateness the best thing to do is talk with your classroom teacher. Teachers are here to understand your situation and help where possible. By discussing these issues we can avoid using the Truancy service which will always be our last resort.

There is a reward shield for class attendance at weekly assembly. Lets all encourage our students to be on time to start class in the morning so they can make the most of every learning opportunity.

Throughout the year we will keep you updated on the progress to improve attendance.

KiVa

At the end of 2018, our students participated in a KiVa survey to see what impact this programme has had on bullying at Dannevirke South School.

A couple of interesting points were:

KiVa

- Children being bullied at Dannevirke South School is lower than other schools involved in KiVa.
- · Children have a clearer understanding of what bullying is- repeated, deliberate and imbalance of power situations.
- Some children can now identify themselves as a bully and work on ways to stop themselves from doing this.
- A high percentage of children at Dannevirke South School feel that their teachers and families see that bullying is bad and not acceptable.

A goal for the KiVa team is to contact the whanau of children who are a bully in 2019. These bullies will be identified in each KiVa case.

On Tuesday 5th March, we will be holding a KiVa information meeting in the school hall starting at 5.30 pm and going to approximately 6.00 pm. All whanau are most welcome to attend, but we would especially love to see all our new families to the school come along and learn about our anti bullying programme.
