At the end of 2019, our students participated in a KiVa survey to see what impact this programme has had on bullying at Dannevirke South School.

A couple of interesting points were:

- ⇒ Children being bullied at Dannevirke South School has decreased and is lower than other schools involved in KiVa.
- ⇒ Children have a clearer understanding of what bullying is- repeated, deliberate and imbalance of power situations.
- ⇒ Some children can now identify themselves as a bully and work on ways to stop themselves from doing this.
- ⇒ A high percentage of children at Dannevirke South School feel that their teachers and families see that bullying is bad and not acceptable.

From this survey, we learnt that not all bullying happening is being reported to teachers. Therefore a goal for the KiVa team is to encourage children to tell teachers about any bullying incidents at Dannevirke South School.
