DANNEVIRKE SOUTH SCHOOL Transition

Transition at Dannevirke South School is a whānau affair. Our aim is to immerse vour tamariki in our learning environment so they become part of our school family. Every week for 10 weeks tamariki and whānau come to school and join in with our class programme. Dannevirke South School offers 'play based learning.' We know the importance of developmentally appropriate learning

opportunities balanced with smaller group work and explicit teaching in 'Reading, Writing and Maths.' Transitioning tamariki will be able to build relationships with new friends, kaiako and reconnect with old friends from Kindy and Pre-School.

Jenna and Caroline will...

- \Rightarrow Build strong relationships with Early Childhood services.
- \Rightarrow Use early childhood records of learning and interviews to get to know your child.
- \Rightarrow Get to know your child's culture, background, interests, strengths, and what they've already learnt (and using this to tailor their learning).
- \Rightarrow Set up a tuakana/teina (buddy system) for your child before they start school.
